The Chairperson Mr. Conrad D'souza presented the performance of the college. The major highlights are as under:

- 1. Successful completion of Admission process for the Academic Year 2018-19 as under:
 - a. B.Sc. Hospitality Studies: 120 admissions against an intake of 180.
 - b. B.A. Culinary Art: 60 admissions as against an intake of 60 students.
 - c. Associate Degree in Culinary Arts: 0 students as against an intake of 60 students.
 - d. Associate Degree in Hospitality Studies: 0 students as against an intake of 60 students.
 - e. M.Sc. (Hotel & Hospitality Administration): 0 students as against an intake of 60 students.

2. Exam Results:

B.Sc. (Hospitality Studies)

98 students appeared for the B.Sc. Hospitality Studies Semester VI Examinations at the University of Mumbai and 91 students passed. The results of 4 students have been kept in abeyance for submission of Eligibility Documents and 3 students have failed. The overall pass percentage is 96.9%.
