## SECOND ROUND

The Finale round was held on 27th February 2024 at 1.30 pm on Google meet.

The recipe presented for this round was Khorisa- Komul, which means bamboo shoot and lotus in Assamese language as the ingredient used for this beverage is widely used in Assam.

The base was homemade black rice wine – 60ml, bamboo shoot & lotus stem tea – 60ml, pineapple & kaffir lime shrub- 20ml, pineapple oleo saccharum- 30ml, garnish – dehydrated pineapple.

And the situation to be handled, given by the judge was;

You are at the bar and there is no senior supervisor present around. There is a lady guest who has been there for more than 2 hours who is completely drunk and unable to walk. Her bill is more than 25,000 rupees. What will you do and how will you handle this situation?

The judge appreciated the recipe and also the way the situation was handled by Ms. Mitali Pilankar which gave Sheila Raheja Institute of Hotel Management (SRIHM) the score of 9 points which made SRIHM win this competition. Kher Nagar



## CONCEPT NOTE

As per the curriculum of Third Year B.Sc. Hospitality Studies Semester VI, there is a course Event Planning Marketing and Management under this subject the students have to plan an event based on the syllabus and guidelines prescribed by the University of Mumbai.

This year the students have proposed to execute an event in the form of Food Festival (Food Stalls) on 12<sup>th</sup> & 13<sup>th</sup> April 2024, wherein the students shall be divided in to 13 groups and each group will have 08-09 students who put up a food stall and the students will sell the finished product to the invited and the walk-in guests.

The advantage of planning this event will give students the expected outcomes

Develop the entrepreneurial and creative skills of our students.

Practically apply theoretical principles of event management.

Develop crisis handling and man-management skills.

Analyze financial viability of an event.

Develop marketing and strategic management skills.

Succeed in a competitive environment.

## The Key points are as follows:

- 1. Lay people along with our non-participating students will come in as guests during the food festival
- 2. The food festival will be open to the public by invitation only between 4.00 pm and 10.00 pm
- 3. The college will provide lighting in public areas and music to create the environment.
- 4. 14 stalls will be put up -13 stalls by students and 01 stall by the college as coupon counter.
- 5. A layout of the entire food festival will be put up informing students of the stalls and their location with entry and exit point for guests.
- 6. Each stall will be a size of 09' by 10' in dimension.
- 7. Students will contribute towards the cost of constructing the food stalls in the college premises.
- 8. The student contribution worked out by students based on the cost towards each stall will be Rs. 3,200/- per student for the two days is decided by the students to contribute for the event utilization Cheques should be drawn in favour of Sheila Raheja Institute of Hotel Management
- 9. The students will be allocated the stalls on basis of draw of lots.
- 10. Students will be given the stalls two days in advance to decorate it.
- 11. Provision of the following will be done by the college
  - a. Four banquet tables
  - b. One tube light





- c. Three points of 05 ampere & one point of 15 ampere
- d. Stall shall be covered on 03 sides
- 12. Each stall will have a faculty as a mentor. The faculty in no way will be involved in any work except guiding, suggesting and handling critical situations.
- 13. Students will be permitted to collect sponsorship in kind, as well as cheques for the event
- 14. No alcohol or alcohol-based products can be used in the stall. Menu will exclude beef and pork products.
- 15. College will not provide cooking or service equipment and the college kitchen will not be available for use. However special provisions shall be made available for frying purpose inside the kitchen.
- 16. College will provide storing facility for the first and second night. The risk of storage will be borne by the students and the college shall not be responsible in case of any spoilage due to fluctuations in temperature or for any other reason whatsoever.
- 17. Students will print food coupons with the denominations of 5 points, 10 points, 20 points, 50 points and 100 points.
- 18. Every stall will have to buy coupon worth 1000 points from the college cashier to enable the smooth cashless transaction.
- 19. Guest will have to purchase food coupons from the coupon counters and it will be exchanged against the food product on any of the stalls.
- 20. Students will sell their displayed products against food coupons.
- 21. At the end of the day the students will collect the food coupons and get reimbursement from the student council cashier.
- 22. Students should handover the stalls in a neat and tidy state after cleaning it thoroughly. Any damages to the stall will be charged to the group.
- 23. All the faculty shall be assigned duties and responsibility to execute the event successfully.





The one-day Faculty Development Program on "APA Style of Referencing for Writing Research Papers "for faculty members was conducted on 2<sup>nd</sup> December 2023 by Ms. Suchismita Roy Indra Assistant Professor/IQAC Coordinator. The objective of the Faculty Development Program was to make faculty aware about the referencing styles used while writing Research Papers.

### **Key Highlights and Discussion Points:**

APA style uses the author/date method of citation in which the author's last name and the year of the publication are inserted in the actual text of the paper. It is the style recommended by the American Psychological Association and used in many of the social sciences.

### When to Reference:

- Reference any information, arguments, or ideas not your own or common knowledge.
- Include references even if content is re-written in your own words.
- Referencing allows readers to check sources and is crucial for scholarly writing.

### **In-Text References:**

- Place in-text references within a sentence before the full stop.
- Two common formats:
  - (Author, Date): Indicates the source of an idea or information.
  - o Author (Date): Emphasizes the author, especially when comparing different sources.

### Summarizing a Source:

- Place the in-text reference near the beginning of the first sentence when summarizing.
- Clearly indicate the source being summarized.

### Reference Page:

- Should be on its own page after the text but before any tables, figures, or appendices.
- Double-spaced throughout, including individual references.
- Formatted with hanging indents (each line after the first line of every entry indented 0.5 inches).

Note: Accurate referencing is vital for maintaining academic integrity and credibility.

### Common APA Referencing Mistakes to Avoid

- Incorrect In-Text Citations:
  - o **Correct**: Use the author's last name and the year of publication.

- **Incorrect**: Omitting the year or author's name.

- **Inaccuracies in Reference List Entries:** 
  - o Correct: New page, hanging indentation, centred heading.
  - o **Incorrect**: Incorrect indentation, improper formatting.
- Failure to Include DOI or URL:
  - o Correct: Always include DOI or URL if available.
  - o **Incorrect**: Omitting these can make it difficult to locate the source.
- Improper Use of Quotations and Paraphrasing:
  - Correct: Include page numbers for quotes; credit the original author when paraphrasing.
  - **Incorrect**: Failing to do so can lead to plagiarism.

Note: Accurate referencing is essential for maintaining academic integrity. Always double-check your citations and references to adhere to APA guidelines.

### **APA Style Citation Guidelines for Online Sources**

### Citing an Entire Website:

- Mention the website in the text without quoting or paraphrasing a specific part.
- Include the URL in parentheses after the site's name.
- No reference page citation is needed.

**Example:** One of the most popular social media sites, Instagram, allows users to share images and videos (https://www.instagram.com).

### Citing Online Articles:

Use the format: Last name, Initials. (Year, Month Day). Article title. Publication Name. URL

**Example:** Greenhouse, S. (2020, July 30). The coronavirus pandemic has intensified systemic economic racism against black Americans. The New Yorker. https://www.newyorker.com/news/news-desk/thecoronavirus-pandemic-has-intensified-systemic-economic-racism-against-black-americans

### **Citing Blog Posts:**

- Blog posts follow a similar format to online articles.
- Use the format: Last name, Initials. (Year, Month Day). Article title. Blog Name. URL
